CAMPAIGN NEWS!

If you choose to pledge online, please remember to also submit your completed pledge card to the parish office for our records.

VOLUNTEER MEETING: Our next volunteer meeting will be held on **Monday, December 1, at 7:00 pm in the Church Hall.**

MAKING YOUR PLEDGE: Our campaign volunteers will continue reaching out over the next few weeks to help you make your pledge. You may even visit with them after Mass! If you are ready to make your pledge or if you have any questions, you may contact our campaign director, Laurie at lwhitfield@lynchdevelopment.com.

THE IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER: If you are aged 70½ or older, you may opt to make a charitable contribution from your qualified IRA plan. When you do so, you may transfer up to \$108,000 per year to Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. As a charitable gift, this distribution needs to be transferred directly from your IRA to the Parish. Therefore, it would not be taxed as income.

GIFTS OF STOCK: If you have held the stock for more than one year, you may take a charitable tax deduction for the current market value of the stock, and neither you nor the parish would pay capital-gains taxes when the stock is sold. The combination can result in a larger deduction (more tax savings) for you and a more generous gift to the campaign than if you sell the stock, pay the taxes and donate the net proceeds.
