**THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)**  
**JOHN 6:51-58**

**CORPUS CHRISTI – THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST**

This Sunday, we celebrate the final of the three great feasts that honor the mystery of God and the mystery of the Church. Today we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi. How fitting it is that we conclude these solemnities with the Eucharist, the “source and summit of the Christian life.”

The Eucharist is at the heart of who we are and what we believe. Without the Eucharist, we would be spiritually deprived of the unique gift of Christ’s life within us. Through this sacrament, the Lord nourishes and strengthens us on our journey of faith.

As we focus on the Eucharist, let us renew our belief that during the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass, the bread and wine are transformed into the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ. This mystery is known as transubstantiation. Christ gives His whole self to us in the Eucharist through His Real Presence. May we ask the Lord to strengthen our faith so that we truly recognize whom we receive in Holy Communion—the Risen Christ Himself. May we never take this great gift for granted.

The Eucharist “preserves, increases, and renews the life of grace received at Baptism” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, §1392). It continues the life of charity first given to us in Baptism. God provides us with heavenly food—the Body and Blood of Jesus—to sustain us throughout our earthly pilgrimage. Through the Eucharist, we share in the eternal life of God. As St. Carlo Acutis beautifully said, the Eucharist is our “highway to Heaven.”

Therefore, we must remember not to receive Holy Communion if we are conscious of mortal sin, since doing so prevents us from receiving the full fruits and effects of the sacrament. Before receiving the Eucharist, I encourage each of us to take time to examine our conscience and, when necessary, seek the Sacrament of Reconciliation, especially if we are in a state of mortal sin.

We might ask ourselves: What is my lifestyle like? What do I need to change? Does my life reflect the Eucharist that I receive each Sunday—or even daily? Am I respectful and charitable toward others?

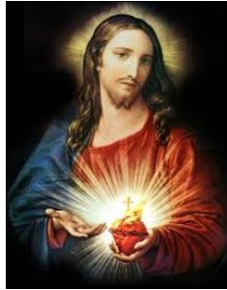
By honestly reflecting on these questions and responding to God’s grace, we can more fully experience the blessings that come from receiving Holy Communion. As we approach the Eucharist—the source and summit of the whole Christian life, toward which all the sacraments and ministries of the Church are directed—let us do everything we can to honor this sacred gift by faithfully responding to what the Church asks of us.

**ECHOING MARY’S FIAT – CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE**

As we enter the summer months, we are preparing to begin several important capital projects for our parish. Our first priorities include:

1. Rectory Boiler
2. Parish Center Boiler
3. Parish Center Steps
4. Church Security Enhancements
5. School Windows & Air Conditioning

In addition, campaign funds from the Maintenance Reserve Fund were recently used to repair the church elevator so it would be operational in time for Easter. All projects must first receive diocesan approval, and projects over \$25,000 require multiple bids before work can begin.



We are happy to share that, thanks to your generosity, we have now collected nearly \$850,000 toward our campaign goal. Thank you to everyone who has pledged and contributed to this important effort as we continue to strengthen our parish for the next 100 years and beyond.



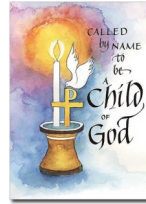


**Pray for Priests**

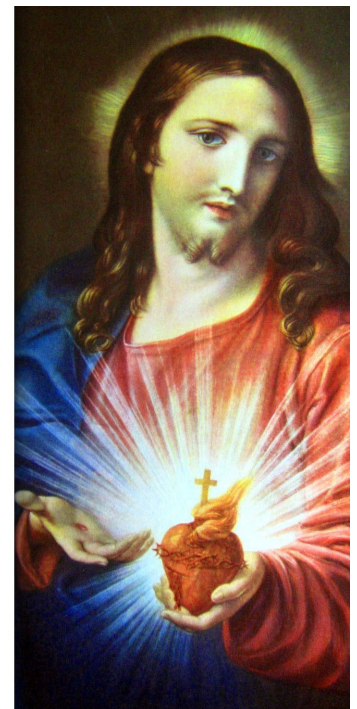

### Family Connection

Every person in the Church is sent by Christ to do the work that he did. This task can seem daunting. The family is one such place in which we work with others, sharing a common task and a common goal.

As family members gather, invite each person to reflect upon their contributions to family life. Invite each one to share one or two things that they do to help keep your family life flowing smoothly. Take time to thank one another for the contributions each person makes to your family life.

Invite a family member to read aloud today's Gospel, Matthew 9:36-10:8. In this Gospel, Jesus sends the disciples to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. Point out that the disciples are called to work together just as family members must work together. Pray together that your family will always work together as a family to help one another. Pray that your family can be a model for other families. Pray together the Lord's Prayer.

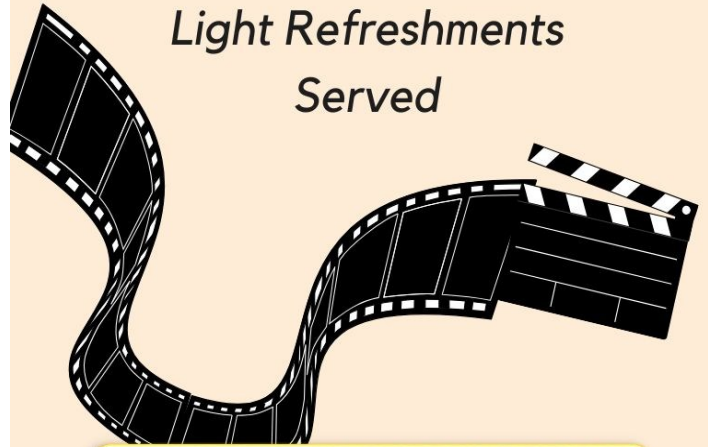

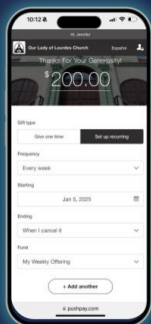
