

REST IN PEACE GOOD AND FAITHFUL SERVANT; FR. RICHARD R. DONOVAN

Last week, I was informed by Fr. Donovan's nephew, Terry, that he had contracted pneumonia and that his health was failing. By God's providence, I was able to pray with him at Belair Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on New Year's Eve. Fr. Richard R. Donovan passed away peacefully on Saturday evening at 9:30 p.m., the Vigil of the Solemnity of the Epiphany.

Fr. Donovan grew up in Bellmore, served as an altar boy at St. Barnabas, and was a graduate of St. Barnabas Elementary School. He attended Chaminade High School and Niagara University before entering Immaculate Conception Seminary in Huntington. He was ordained in 1958 by Bishop Kellenberg for the Diocese of Rockville Centre and was the last surviving priest of his ordination class.

During his priestly ministry, Fr. Donovan served at St. Vincent de Paul in Elmont, Holy Family in Hicksville, St. Martin of Tours in Amityville, Our Lady of Victory in Floral Park, and St. Anne's in Garden City. In 1977, Bishop McGann appointed him Pastor of St. Thomas More in Hauppauge, making him the youngest pastor in the diocese at that time. In 2001, he came to Our Lady of Lourdes in Malverne, where he served until 2021. In January 2022, he moved to Belair Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in North Bellmore.

Fr. Donovan is survived by his sister, Joaann; his nephew, Terry (Christine), and family; and Stephen. He was preceded in death by his brother, Leo.

Fr. Donovan was known for his dry sense of humor, love of storytelling, and his memorable New Year's Day homilies, which always ended with "Happy New Year." May this good and faithful servant of God rest in the peace of Christ.


WELCOME FR. DUFFY

Please welcome the Very Rev. Michael Duffy, who is celebrating the 12:00 Noon Mass today. I am grateful for all the work he has done here at Our Lady of Lourdes, paving the way for my priestly ministry with you.



Fr. Duffy served as pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish beginning in June 2017. At the time of his appointment, Fr. Duffy was the youngest pastor in the history of the Diocese of Rockville Centre. From 2016 to 2019, he also served as the Catholic Chaplain at Long Island University Post in Brookville. Ordained in June 2012, Fr. Duffy was first assigned as an associate pastor at St. Kilian Parish in Farmingdale.

Fr. Duffy graduated from MacArthur High School in Levittown and attended Fordham University at the Rose Hill Campus, where he earned



a bachelor's degree with a major in Philosophy and a minor in Theology. He then entered the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington, earning both a Master of Divinity degree and a Master's degree in Theology. Fr. Duffy recently completed a Master's degree in Ecclesiastical Administration from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.
