Reflection for Next Sunday

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 9, 2026

First Reading: *1 Kings 19:9a,11-13a*

Second Reading: *Romans 9:1-5*

Gospel Reading: *Matthew 14:22-33*

Jesus walks on water, and the disciples acknowledge him as the Son of God.

Family Connection

The mission of the Church is to continue the work of Jesus. The family, the domestic church, participates in this mission too.

Talk about how your family participates in the mission of the Church. Discuss ways in which you seek to reach out to your neighbors and people in need through acts of kindness, mercy, and justice. Then read together today's Gospel, Matthew 14:22-33. Talk about how Peter wanted to be like Jesus, to walk on water like Jesus did. Note that Peter was successful for a time, but then he doubted Jesus, and he began to sink into the water. Talk about how your family's acts of mercy and justice are rooted in your faith in Jesus. Pray together that Jesus will continue to work through your family to prepare the kingdom of heaven. Pray together the Morning Offering or the Lord's Prayer.

Fiat Update: We are pleased to share an update on the progress of our Capital Campaign, *Echoing Mary's Fiat Through Generations*. Thanks to your continued generosity and support, several important parish improvement projects are moving forward.

We are happy to report that the leak in the church roof has been successfully repaired.

The replacement of the boilers in both the Rectory and the Parish Center will begin shortly and will be completed by Quality Air Conditioning and Heating, Inc.

We are also awaiting the architect's drawings for the reconstruction of the Parish Center front steps, which will include the addition of an ADA-accessible ramp.

In addition, planning continues for future security enhancements to our church and improvements to the air conditioning system in our school building.

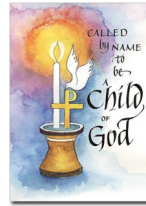

Principal's Message



As we continue preparing for another exciting school year at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic School, this Sunday's Gospel offers a beautiful reminder that God takes the little we offer Him and transforms it into something extraordinary.

When the disciples looked at the enormous crowd, they saw only five loaves and two fish—not nearly enough to meet the need before them. Jesus, however, saw something different. He saw willing hearts, an opportunity to trust in God's providence, and the possibility of a miracle.

As our school community begins the 2026–2027 academic year under our theme, "Mary's Yes...Our Yes: Growing in Faith • Learning with Purpose • Leading with Love," we are invited to respond just as Mary did—with confidence and trust in God's plan.

Each day, our students are called to offer their own "five loaves and two fish":

their willingness to learn,
their kindness toward others,
their perseverance through challenges,
their gifts and talents,
and their faith in Christ.

When these simple offerings are placed into God's hands, He multiplies them in remarkable ways. A classroom becomes a community. Lessons become lifelong wisdom. Acts of kindness become habits of service. Faith grows stronger, friendships deepen, and young hearts are formed into disciples who will make a difference in the world.

At Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic School, we believe that every child has unique gifts given by God. Our responsibility as educators and parents is to help each student discover those gifts, develop them with excellence, and use them in service to others.

As we approach the first day of school, let us pray that our students, faculty, and families will never underestimate what God can accomplish through a generous heart. NY Hospice Nuns Face Fines, Loss of License and Jail Time for not Bending to NY State Gender Regulations

On Mar. 18, 2024 the sisters of the Rosary Hill Home received letters from NY State notifying them they must conform to the NYS regulations to align patient care with the state's gender ideology laws.

Those laws require Rosary Hill Home and other long-term care facilities to house biological men in women's rooms even over the opposition of a female roommate, to permit residents and their visitors of one sex to access bathrooms set aside for those of the opposite sex, to use false pronouns, to use language and "create communities" affirming patients' sexual preferences, and to accommodate patients desire for extramarital sexual relations.

For 125 years the Dominican order of nuns at Rosary Hill Home have cared for those dying of incurable cancer during the last months of their lives. The sisters charge nothing for the care and attribute their ability to comfort and care for so many dying patients to their faith and the presence of the Eucharist.

Mother Marie Edward, General Superior of the Dominican nuns, said:

"We Sisters have taken care of patients from all walks of life, ideologies, and faiths. We treat each patient with dignity and Christian charity. We have never had complaints. We cannot implement New York's mandate without violating our Catholic faith." <https://tinyurl.com/bd hx67zt>

The lawyer for the Dominican Sisters stated that the nuns don't even have such patients and never have. "It's the state requiring these holy nuns to bend the knee to an ideology contrary to their faith."

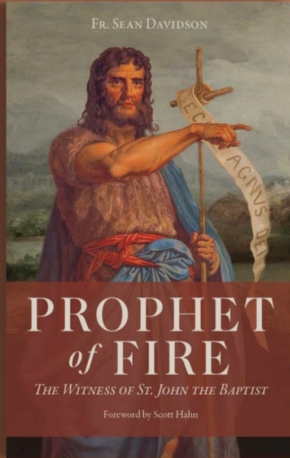

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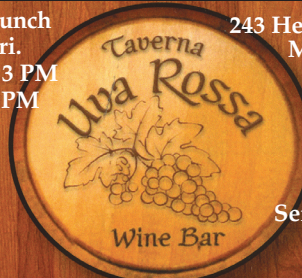


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
